St. Andrew Feast Day Liturgy & Dinner – Sunday, December 5, 2021. Liturgy will be at 11:00AM with Homily in both languages. Bishop Bohdan Danylo will be the main celebrant. Immediately following this liturgy, a ticketed dinner will be held in our back hall (approximately 1:00pm). Tickets are \$25 for adults; \$10 for youth (ages 6-15); and children under 5 are free. When you purchase your tickets, you will also select your table assignment. **Last day for ticket sales is Monday, November 29th. No tickets will be sold the day of the event.** Come and congratulate Deacon Biagio and Deacon Andriy at this event, too.
