**LET’S SUPPORT THE CREATION OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE HOLODOMOR-GENOCIDE IN KYIV in the month of November** ... For Ukrainians, the month of November is a time for honoring the victims of the Holodomor, and the terrible and planned by the Stalinist-Soviet regime famine of Ukrainians in Central, Eastern and Southern Ukraine and Kuban in 1932-1933. The forced and prolonged famine of millions of Ukrainians has led to the deaths of at least 10.5 million people according to latest research data! It was a deliberate policy in response to the resistance of freedom-loving peasants against the collectivization introduced in 1928, when private land, livestock and agricultural implements were taken to form collective farms and forced to work on collective farms paying with grain not enough to feed their families....To honor the victims of the Holodomor, to collect and study the history of the Holodomor, the Ukrainian government approved the establishment of a Memorial to the Victims of the Holodomor.
